Course description

This interactive course addresses the complex interlinkages between poverty and environmental degradation in dryland regions and raises awareness of the problems and global implications of desertification. It introduces the UN Convention to Combat Desertification and Drought as an innovative global tool for coordinated actions between governments, civil society and international agencies. It highlights the Convention's fundamental principles and raises awareness of the importance of National Action Programs developed by many countries around the world.

Participants will discuss the most critical issues relating to effective implementation at the national, regional and international levels, and will gain a good understanding of the global challenge posed by increasing desertification.
