Scheduled Courses

The following courses are scheduled to be conducted by NETWAS International in Nairobi.

- Monitoring for effectiveness: Improving community based water supply and sanitation projects, Nairobi, Kenya. (19 February - 9 March 2001) - Suitable for the water, sanitation and health sector staff responsible for policy level management and project/programme managers in government, funding agencies, NGOs or private organisations. The course focusses on developing and implementing new, more participatory monitoring strategies. It is offered by NETWAS in collaboration with IRC of the Netherlands.
- 2 Hygiene Education and Promotion: planning and management for behavioral change, Nairobi, Kenya (19 March— 6 April 2001) — Suitable for staff responsible for planning and development of hygiene promotion activities in water and sanitation programmes. It is offered by NETWAS in collaboration with IRC of The Netherlands.
- 6 Solid Waste Management, Nairobi, Kenya. (14 25 May 2001) The course is designed to benefit engineering staff and public health officers working in urban, peri-urban areas and municipalities, involved in urban environmental management issues. The course is offered by NETWAS in collaboration with SANDEC and SKAT of Switzerland with special input from the Water and Sanitation Program -East and Southern Africa(WSP-ESA).

(17 September -- 5 October 2001) -- Suitable for sector staff who are responsible for policy level managerment, district/provincial operations and those working as project managers/officers in government, NGOs or private organisations. The course is offered by NETWAS in collaboration with IRC of The Netherlands.
- Management and Institutional Options for Rural and Urban Water and Environmental Sanitation Projects (22 October—9 November 2001) —The course is designed for sector staff in local authorities, community organisations and trainers who plan, develop, implement and coordinate water supply and sanitation programmes. The course will be offered by NETWAS in collaboration with SKAT of Switzerland and WSP-ESA.
- Tommunity Management of Water Supply and Sanitation Programmes (19 November---7 December 2001) —The course is meant for staff involved in developing and supporting community management initiatives. It is intended to anchor the learning capacities and skills in organizations and projects.
