Oxfam education resources for schools 2001/2002

We are delighted to enclose our new Oxfam catalogue for schools, hot off the press!

This year's catalogue features over 80 new titles from a wide range of organisations and publishers, including – for the first time – Tara Publishing in India (*Craft Without Limits* series, page 22), Maskew Miller Longman in South Africa (*They Fought for Freedom* series, page 9) and Ian Randle Publishers in Jamaica (*The Pan-Africanists*, page 10).

- ★ Our new catalogue contains an expanded **Citizenship** section, with many new and imaginative resources for teachers, including *Global Citizenship: The Handbook for Primary Teachers* (page 2), *Local Citizen*, *Global Citizen* (page 3), and *Citizenship Education* (page 4).
- ★ Innovative resources to support development of **Numeracy** skills include *Photo Opportunities Maths*, *One Child, One Seed*, and *Water Numerate* (all on page 23).
- ★ New resources to assist teachers of **Geography** in their classroom work include *Waking Up* (page 15), *India: Children's Needs, Children's Rights* (page 17), and two new titles in the popular *Country Profiles* series – *Bolivia and Uganda* (page 19).
- ★ Building on the success of the much-loved book *Wake Up, World!* (page 9), we are delighted to offer 2 new resources linking to this book – *Your World, My World* (page 2), a photopack exploring the lives of 4 children across the world, and the *Wake Up, World!* CD-Rom (page 9), which includes activities and documentaries about the lives of 6 children across the world. Children will recognise many of the faces from the pages of the book.


