Development, NGOs, and Civil Society

Introduction by Jenny Pearce

As organisations of civil society, NGOs are a convenient channel through which donors can promote political pluralism. But can NGOs both facilitate governments' withdrawal from providing basic services and also represent the poor and the disenfranchised who depend on these services? Are NGOs legitimate political actors in their own right?
