This *Handbook* provides guidance to developing countries that wish to promote policies aimed at increasing efficiency in their services sector, including by means of liberalizing foreign investment and trade in services. The *Handbook* examines a comprehensive list of instruments that are used to limit international transactions in services, including the supply of services to foreign markets through different modes of delivery - foreign direct investment, movement of labour, movement of consumers and cross-border trade - and suggests how reform of such instruments may contribute to creating conditions of efficiency in service sectors. The *Handbook* also provides some insights into practical issues associated with the implementation of liberalization in the services sector, drawing upon individual country experiences.
